

Entry is deemed to be acceptance of these conditions:

This event will be run under the [Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024](#).

A valid passport including up to date [flu vac](#) record must be carried. Spot checks will be made at the event.

All hats must be tagged to comply with the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2024](#), with a **PINK hat tag. HAT tagging will be available at the information point.**

[New Rule 2024 Body Protectors](#) BETA Level 3 2018 must be worn for the cross-country phase, and as a minimum, shoulders must be covered when competing. Air jackets if worn for XC, must be over a body protector.

New Rule 2024 No Whips are allowed in the dressage phase at PC90 and PC100.
New Rule 2024 Time penalties will be incurred for going too slow in the PC80.
No stop watches are allowed at PC70 and PC80.

Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old. No horse/pony may compete more than once. No-one other than the competitor may ride the pony at the event.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside **at any time**.

Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.

Health & Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials, and stewards.
